Naval Hospital Guam is comprised of the main hospital in Agana Heights, and two branch clinics, medical and dental, on Naval Base Guam. The Naval Hospital's staff consists of 516 Active Duty and 201 civilians, contractors, reservists and volunteers who serve more than 26,000 beneficiaries.

Winergy was awarded the contract (one year +4) to provide field certification of all of pharmacy clean rooms and compounding equipment. This is a unique contract in that Guam is a United States territory and the most isolated. Located 3,950 west of Hawaii, Guam is challenging to access but still requires the same level of rigorous attention and standards as state-side facilities.

The POC has lauded our work so far and has worked to expand our responsibilities at the facility. Winergy has provided consulting at no additional cost as the pharmacy area undergoes renovation. Discovered multiple unknown issues and provided useful recommendations for corrective actions.
